Programme designed to fit your busy schedule

Healthcare is entering a period of accelerated, disruptive innovation with rapid discovery and adoption of new approaches to improve patient outcomes. To thrive and lead in a world of increased complexity requires skills in innovative thinking and creative execution. Through this **one year Postgraduate Diploma programme (NFQ Level 9)** you will be supported to develop a personal innovation framework for leadership. You will be ready to implement future health solutions, stepping up to the next level in your career development. This programme:

- Develops personal and professional capacity to **lead** innovation in healthcare.
- Encourages practical understanding of applying **new technologies** in healthcare.
- Critically appraises **innovation theory and practice** to inform your approach in applying solutions at the forefront of **global healthcare**.
- Examines the role of **health economics**, quality improvement and the **principles of governance** in leading effective innovation.

Programme Overview - 2024/2025

Structure

Delivered through the School of Medicine Trinity College Dublin, the Postgraduate Diploma in Healthcare Innovation is a one year NFQ level 9 (60 ECTS credits) course. The course comprises of eight taught modules - six foundation modules and two project modules - and includes methodology workshops and practical field projects delivered via blended teaching in classroom and online. Each of the taught modules is delivered over a single weekend consisting of full-day Friday and full-day Saturday to minimise interference with busy schedules. Full attendance is mandatory. If pandemic restrictions are active at the time of delivery, the modules will move online.

Assessment

Participants are assessed on a module by module basis through a variety of practical assignments. The emphasis throughout the programme is on the practical application of knowledge to benefit the participant, their team, and their healthcare organisations.

Accreditation

On successful completion of the programme, graduates will be awarded the Postgraduate Diploma in Healthcare Innovation by the School of Medicine, Trinity College Dublin, The University of Dublin. They will become part of the national network of HIHI Innovation Champions.

- ✓ Healthcare and health-related professional.
- ✓ 2:1 Undergraduate Degree, PG Diploma *or* Master's Degree.
- ✓ Completed Application Form.
- ✓ 2 References (1 academic).
- ✓ Proof of proficiency in English.

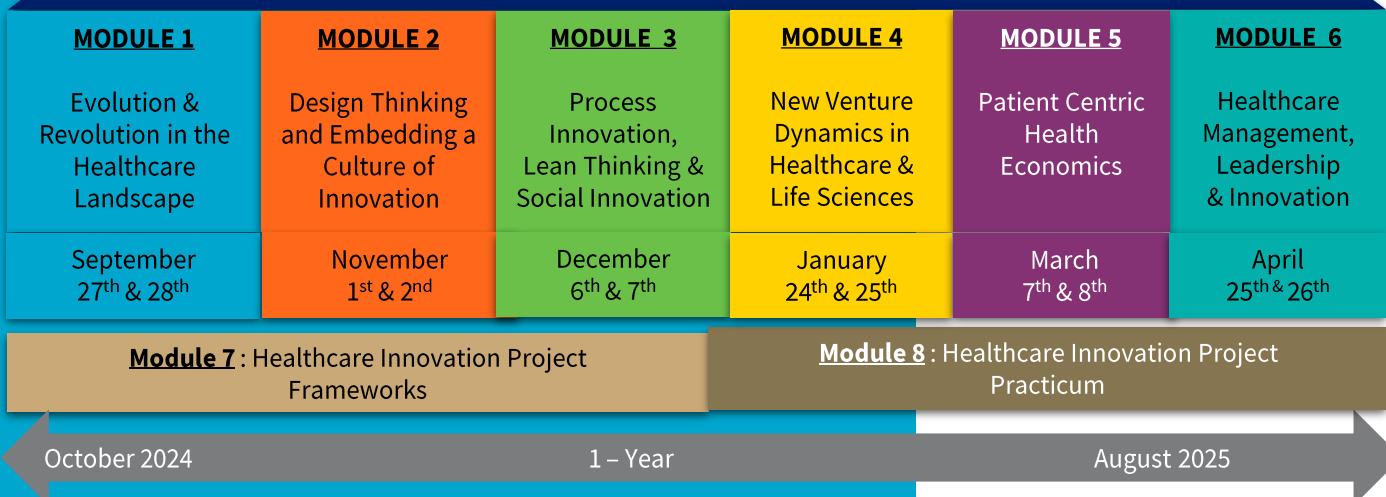


Tuition Fees:
